Jacqueline Hill (*incumbent*)

Over the past decade, Jacqueline A. Hill has continued to demonstrate executive leadership in federal aviation programs and strategic consulting. She served as Deputy Director of Enterprise Services at the Federal Aviation Administration, overseeing approximately 200 employees and a \$1B portfolio supporting telecommunications, navigation, and weather systems within the National Airspace System. During this period, she contributed to multiple acquisition and risk governance boards. After retiring, Jacqueline transitioned to consulting, serving as Principal Consultant with COBEC Consulting, where she supported FAA programs and strategic business development. In 2021, she founded Rooths Solutions LLC, providing acquisition support and strategic planning to government agencies and contractors.
